

<p>EL SERENO SLIDE</p> <p>INTRODUCTION</p>	<p>Part of a hill gave way in the San Gabriel Valley today, and forced more than a hundred people to evacuate their homes.</p>
<p>At: 00 MS cars and apartment</p> <p>Dur 7:00 + 1:00</p>	<p>The slide collapsed a parking lot next to four apartment buildings. It created a sinkhole that trapped several cars in the deep gorge.</p>
<p>At:09 cu fireman</p> <p>Dur 7:00</p>	<p>Fire officials are worried the apartment complex might also tumble down the hill, so they ordered the evacuation.</p>
<p>At :27:04 pan to hill</p> <p>Dur 6:00</p>	<p>The cause of the slide is believed to be related to construction at the bottom of the hill.</p>
<p>At :33:04 steel beams</p> <p>Dur 8:00</p>	<p>Workers had driven steel beams to support the hill for a new condominium complex. But the effort didn't work.</p>
<p>At :41:04 leaving</p> <p>Dur 10:00 + 5:00</p> <p>T.R.T.</p>	<p>And now many residents say they aren't sure they EVER want to return, even if the hill and their apartments are eventually declared safe.</p>
